Child MISS gives fast and accurate data to the organizations that takes care of children and also finds a safe hand for young children who are at risk every minute of the uncertain life.

ORIGIN AND BRIEF HISTORY OF THE ORGANIZATION

There was growing awareness of the ever-increasing number of street children in the nooks and corners of Salem city in the mid-1980s. Surprisingly, the plight of these children was not covered under any existing socio-political scheme or programme. They were not even considered in the population census of the state of Tamil Nadu. This alarming situation captured the attention of some students of philosophy, who have their academic center at The Retreat, Yercaud, a hill station, 30 Km away from Salem. During their weekend ministry they started contacting these street kids at the city bus station and railway junction and wanted to rehabilitate and mainstream them in to the society. Their unquenchable desire and dream had become the genesis of a marvelous rehabilitation center called Don Bosco Anbu Illam a center for the young at risk. Anbu Illam came into existence in the year 1988 under the able leadership of Rev. Fr. Francis Schlooz.

VISION

The vision of the organization is **"Creating a just and equal society based on harmony and universal brotherhood where child rights are ensured"**. To achieve this vision, the organization has an effective rehabilitation packages such as Shelter Homes, Childline - 1098, Reception Unit for Boys, Open Shelter, Child Rights Protection Center, Dropout Prevention Center, Vocational Training Center, Supplementary Education, Caring Community Groups and Child MISS (Management Information System and Services) for these vulnerable children namely, street and working children, missing and trafficked children, HIV/AIDS affected and infected children and marginalized youth which comprises of their Rescue, Restoration, Rehabilitation and Reformation.

MISSION

Don Bosco Anbu Illam, Salem is a catalyst organization that will increase the cooperation and collaboration of people's organization and empower the community by making sure equal and standard education for all, create employment through vocational training, create awareness and sensitization about the human rights and make people take part in governance through networking with NGO's and CBO's for the eradication of social discrimination among the people in order to create the just and equal society based on harmony and universal brotherhood where child rights are ensured.

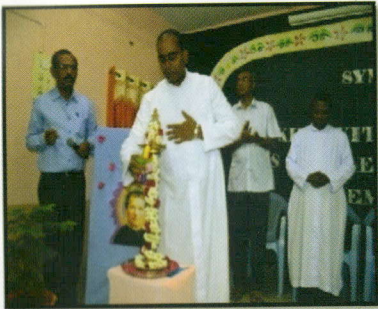
SUCCESS STORIES

After my parents got separated, I was not willing to stay at home or to continue my studies. After opting out of school my maternal uncle took me with him to Chinnathirupathi. He used to treat me badly and make me do all the menial jobs of his house. It was then CHILDLINE rescued me and I was given shelter, food and necessary medical assistance. As part of the follow up programme the CHILDLINE team from Don Bosco Anbu Illam made several visits and counselled me and helped me to forget the bitter experiences and to have a positive outlook towards life. They also helped to enhance my computer skills and complete my schooling. Now I have completed my schooling and six months diploma in computer basics with certification. Currently I am placed in one of the renowned jewellery shops in Salem and am earning Rs.7000/-. At present I am staying with my mother and supporting, my younger sister's education. I am very grateful to Don Bosco Anbu Illam for their care and support.



I used to study in Government Boys Higher Secondary School, after failing in State board government exam I lost interest in studies and dropped out of school. My parents insisted in joining private tutorial, that is when I heard about Don Bosco dropout prevention center and got myself enrolled for the same. At Don Bosco Anbu Illam I was given special coaching for the subjects I had failed during the exam. They also motivated me to continue my studies. Now I have completed 10th standard and also completed a diploma in front office management. I was then placed in a browsing center as system operators and started to earn Rs. 7000/- per month. Along with my parents, I am grateful to Don Bosco Anbu Illam for empowering me with necessary skills and motivating me to come up in life.
